FIVE-STAND POLICY**

**FIVE-STAND POLICY FOR MEMBERS  
EFFECTIVE April 5, 2011**

Any club member in good standing, who is an RSO, and wants to use the five-stand at any location must receive appropriate training and be approved by the Executive Committee.

The RSO may use the five-stand at a location of their choice for a personal activity at no cost. A request must be submitted to and approved by the Executive Committee. The RSO must provide his/her own targets for the activity and assumes all liability for any injuries or damage to the participants at the event or their personal property.

It is assumed that the activity is truly a personal one (i.e. son's birthday party, activity for one's employees, church, etc) and not for the monetary benefit of an organization to which the club member belongs.

**FIVE-STAND POLICY FOR GROUPS/ORGANIZATIONS  
EFFECTIVE APRIL 5, 2011**

Any group wishing to use the five-stand shall make the request in writing to the Club at least one month in advance, and the request must be approved by the Executive Committee

The group shall be charged \$200.00 for the use of the five-stand. Two club members who are RSOs and who have had training in the operation and transportation of the five-stand shall operate the five-stand at the event and shall transport the five-stand to and from the event. Those members shall be paid at a rate negotiated between them and the group for which they work. The group using the five-stand must provide their own targets, and that group must assume all liability for any injuries or damage to the participants at the event or their personal property or to the five-stand. Under no circumstance may the five-stand be used without the club members being present.

Any exceptions to the above policy must be approved by the Executive Committee.

This written policy must be given to any group requesting the use of the five-stand.
