

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT FOR THE CAPE GIRARDEAU COUNTY
GUN CLUB AND THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

I, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree, on behalf of myself and for my minor children accompanying me, personally assume all risks in connection with shooting or other activities conducted at the Apple Creek Conservation Area Trap and Skeet Range. I also agree that I, my heirs, distributes, guardians, or legal representatives will not make a claim against, sue, tax the property of, or in any way pursue a claim arising out of my participation in or presence at any Cape Girardeau County Gun Club or Missouri Department of Conservation event for any incident which may befall on me, or by my hand, resulting in personal injury, death, or property damage, resulting from negligence or other acts, whether caused by the negligence of the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club or the Missouri Department of Conservation management personnel or guests on the facility or otherwise. I am aware that shooting and being a spectator while others are attempting to shoot with a gun is a potentially hazardous activity, and I am voluntarily participating in these activities with the knowledge of the danger involved in them and have been given an opportunity to ask questions and have reviewed the program and safety rules of the facility. I also understand that slight variations may occur in the safety precautions taken by the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club and the Missouri Department of Conservation management and I am willing to accept these changes without reservation. I further understand that I have a choice of whether to participate or not to participate in shooting activities, and I further understand that I cannot participate in any shooting activities without signing this Release and Indemnity Agreement. I am fully aware that the privilege to participate in shooting activities will not be offered to me if I do not execute a complete release and discharge of liability for the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club, its employees, members, officers, volunteers or sponsors of any event; and the Missouri Department of Conservation their employees, members, officers, volunteers or sponsors of any event. By signing this agreement I agree to follow all instruction and safety provisions set out by the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club and the Missouri Department of Conservation. I also understand that in the event that the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club or the Missouri Department of Conservation personnel determine that said safety rules or procedures are not being strictly followed, I will immediately be asked to discontinue my activities at the Apple Creek Conservation Area Trap and Skeet Range and I will voluntarily leave the premises. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Cape Girardeau County Gun Club, its employees, officers, members, volunteers and the sponsors of any event and the Missouri Department of Conservation, its employees, officers, members, volunteers and the sponsors of any event harmless for any injury or damage caused in any way by me or to me.

RANGE RULES

1. Anyone may call a cease fire at any time. All shooters must immediately obey this command, unload their firearm, and open the action.
2. All range rules and range safety officer commands must be obeyed immediately at all times.
3. All guns must be unloaded, the actions open and the muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times. All guns stored in a rack must be unloaded. Automatic and pump action shotguns must have the actions open in the rack.
4. Loading is permitted only when shooter is preparing to shoot and in the designated shooting station.
5. All firearm actions must be opened immediately after shooting and before the shooter turns to leave the shooting station.
6. Only one shell for Trap singles or two for Trap doubles. Two shells for Skeet (except Station 8) may be loaded at one time in the firearm.
7. A maximum of five shooters per squad per round is permitted.
8. Picking up empty hulls during a round of shooting is prohibited. Shooters may pick up empty hulls after completion of the round or as designated by the RSO.
9. In the event of a malfunction, when a live round remains in the gun, the shooter must call a cease-fire. All shooting on the affected field must cease until the condition is corrected. In the case of a hang-fire, do not open the action for at least 30 seconds.
10. Fire only from designated Trap stations that are the blue squares, numbered one through five, on the back arc of the Trap range. Fire only from designated Skeet stations that are the blue squares, numbered one through eight, on the Skeet range.
11. No one is permitted in front of or inside the Trap or Skeet house while in use. No one is allowed past the firing line or the most forward shooting position on the Trap or Skeet range at any time while the field is in use.
12. Only sporting shotguns fired from the shoulder are permitted. Tactical shotguns are not permitted.
13. Shot sizes are limited to a maximum size of 7½ and no shotgun larger than a 12 gauge may be used.
14. A range officer may inspect ammunition and reject its use if it does not conform to range rules.
15. Anyone wishing to use this facility or join in an existing party must check in at the range booth service window.
16. Spectators must remain behind the fence.
17. Skeet shooters in the same round must remain in the same area and move together as a group.
18. All shooters must wear hearing and eye protection at all times when on the range.

I have read and understand the range rule presented above. I agree to abide by these rules while using the Apple Creek Range. I understand that failure to obey these regulations may result in my being denied use of the Apple Creek Range.
