This permit is subject to the following conditions and terms:

1. This permit is not transferable. In addition, a Field Trial Permit is required for all field trials (See Wildlife Code of Missouri).
2. Permittee may use the property only for the designated purpose and will avoid practices detrimental to forestry, wildlife, or agricultural crops. He shall not cut any vegetation, start any open fires, destroy any agricultural crops, post any signs, or construct any structures without written consent of a Department representative. All Activities will be in compliance with the Wildlife Code of Missouri.
3. **Permittee will dispose of all litter and trash generated by activities conducted under the terms of this permit.** Disposal will be in accordance with direction of a Department representative.
4. Vehicles will be restricted to the graveled surface roads and parking lots approved for public use. Emergency vehicles or other specific vehicles may be authorized special access by a Department representative.
5. Permittee agrees that the Conservation Commission, its officers, agent or employees are not liable for any claim whatsoever for damage to equipment, property or injury arising in connection with any activity conducted or undertaken under the terms of this permit.

6. Use of fully automatic weapons, armor piercing rounds, explosive devices, incendiary devices or tracer rounds is prohibited for all users unless specifically authorized herein by range management.
7. Range supervision will be provided by:

8. Permittee must provide written "Course of Fire" narrative before permit is considered valid.
9. There are no other conditions or agreements except as follows:
10. A qualified or certified Range Safety Officer must be assigned and on duty at all times. The officer shall provide the necessary supervision to assure good conduct of users, safety to permittee participants and the general public using the other portions of the range, and the clean-up of the area.
11. The group must provide and require usage of eye and ear protection for all their shooters.

Special requirements or limitations on use: This permit does not allow private use of the range during qualification procedures. The gate should be kept opened and the public should be allowed access and full use of the range other than the box berm area. It is the Range Safety Officer's responsibility to watch out for the safety of the public and assure that the public be allowed to shoot on the targets outside of the box berm. Special use participants should limit their use of inside the box berm only.
